Saipan & Tinian Production Update

Those of you following along with this game know that I had originally intended to release it in the first quarter of 2010.

That did not happen, due in part to my locating a box vendor that can provide full cover boxes at a reasonable price so I had to gear up for that, and also some pre-production proofing that resulted in an additional round of review for the rules and charts to achieve maximum clarity and a minimum of errata. In addition, the release of the game was most recently pushed back because the die-cut counters were rejected due to a misalignment issue with the fronts/back.

The artwork for the box and the maps is complete, as is the final layout of the rules and charts. I am currently waiting for the counter reprints to show up from the printer and once they are assembled they will be sent off to the die-cutter. Hopefully that will be the last production hurdle I have to jump to get this game out the door and on to your gaming table.

Those of you who have Pre-Ordered this title will receive an email notification when the game is ready for shipping. The email will contain a link to the LWG Pre-Order Payment page where you can add one, or more, copies of the game to your cart and check out via Paypal.

This game is now in the final stages of production and is scheduled to be released in June/July, 2010.

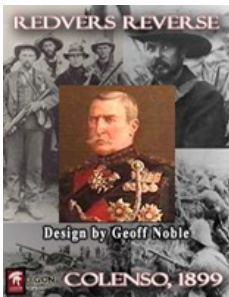

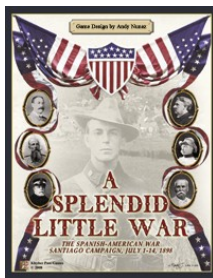

Of course there are game collectors out there who want to keep their games in an "unpunched" condition.

Care will need to be exercised when handling the sheets as only a minimal amount of pressure is required to punch them out. However, if you do decide to punch the counters I am sure you will find them to be of the highest quality, and certainly the easiest and quickest to punch, so you can spend less time punching and trimming counters and more of time playing the game.

CSR Award Nominee: A Splendid Little War

Designed by Andy Nunez, and the last title produced by Khyber Pass Games, this game has been nominated for a CSR Award in the category of Best Post-Napoleonic to Pre-World War 2 Era Board Wargame.



A Splendid Little War is the most detailed game available covering the Santiago Cuba Campaign of 1898. The game covers the entire campaign and includes the Rough Riders, Cuban (and Spanish) Guerrillas, Gatling Guns, the US Observation Balloon, Engineers, and more. Most of the units are regiments and battalions, and the US regiments can break down into quasi battalion sized units in order to trade off strength for speed, and also to absorb combat losses. The US, with more firepower and better artillery, has the upper hand but the dug in Spanish defenders, the relief column's arrival, and the ensuing Yellow fever will all take their toll on the US forces and could turn A Splendid Little War into a costly little defeat.
